
Wisconsin County Human Service Association Associate Member Policy

Per the bylaws of the Wisconsin County Human Service Association (WCHSA), the requirements for Associate Membership are: any agency or program which is associated with one or more county human service program(s), has a demonstrated interest in the administration of human service programs, and provides a comprehensive range of services under public or private auspices is eligible to become an Associate Member of WCHSA.

Except as specifically provided in the bylaws, Associate Members are not eligible to: (1) vote on any matters requiring a vote of the membership; (2) serve on the Board; or (3) hold an office in WCHSA. Associate Member organizations shall identify a board member or executive staff member as the main representative for WCHSA, and are able to identify up to three individuals associated with their organization that would be eligible to receive the benefits of membership.

Associate Membership in WCHSA provides the following benefits:

1. Discounted rates for the WCHSA spring and fall conferences
2. Access to the WCHSA directory
3. WCHSA e-news updates
4. Networking opportunities with WCHSA members

Dues for Associate Membership are \$100 per year (January 1 to December 31). Interested parties should complete the Associate Member application form and submit it along with full payment to the WCHSA Executive Director.
